
Hummer 2



Before starting, check the wheels from the previous lesson.


Once checked pop out the wheel with the + in the center and 6 walls.

*You have one extra wall on the wooden sheet if needed.



Glue the walls into the cracks on the wheel






Take another round wheel,

Make sure the center "+" of each wheel are aligned





top of each wall and place the large wheel on top of the walls. Align the holes so all the wall are inserted correctly into the large wheel. Make sure the center "+" sign of each circle is aligned.



Check all the wheels, if assembled correctly, continue and assemble the 2nd wheel. Repeat the steps until you have 2 completed wheels.


Check both wheels before continuing.



Pop out the part shown in the picture.




Pop out the two pieces shown in the picture. We have 6 similar parts, make sure you are popping out the right parts.

The cracks closest the large hole (red arrow)





Glut the other part as well.

Check all the models.




Pop out the two pieces shown in the picture. We have 6 similar parts, make sure you are popping out the right parts.







Glue the parts to their place, they should be glued next to the parts we previously glued (look at red arrows)

CHECKPOINT!!!
