


Before continuing to the next part, please check the parts from last class.

Keep working one chair at a time



Continue ONE CHAIR AT A TIME!


Take one long part, hand the kids 1 regular 10 screw and one NYLOCK locknut



Place the long bar behind the chair, insert the screw and tighten it with the locknut.





One by one complete all the chairs.





After checking the chairs again, you can continue to the next part.

Pop out the largest circle, and two "plus" parts.




Glue the "plus" parts into their correct cracks.




Once glued, pop out the small circle with the small cracks.

Make sure all the kids pop out the right part before gluing it to the think part of the "pluses"




Once done, check the models.

Flip the large circle so we can see the wide part of the “pluses”



Pop out the small circle with the wide cracks. Glue this part on top of the “pluses” wide part.



This should give us a sandwich. Small circle, large one and a small one on top.

Make sure all the circles are aligned, if needed, help the students fix their models.

Once done, check all the pieces. Tell the kids to put the glued parts in their bags, instructors can collect the remaining wooden sheets, clean the classroom. And when class is over dismiss the kids.
