




Alex- lesson plan #3





Disassemble and file parts in the photo. Then glue as shown in photo #2



Glue the part to its place, notice face's direction. If you look straight at Alex, the glued part will be on the right. Place students' models next to the photo to assure correct assembly.



Disassemble the top lip, and glue it to its place.




File the eyebrows. Then, glue them in its place, and strengthen the connection with the wooden triangle.



Disassemble one wooden ellipse, and file it. Then, hand students a 30 screw, 2 nylock locknuts and a bead.



String the bead onto the screw, then lock with a locknut and tighten as much as possible (so that the bead can't move).



Insert the screw into the fitting hole in the eyebrow, and lock with a nylock locknut. Make sure the locknut is tightened all the way, then undo 2 full circles so that the eye can move.



Do the same thing with the second eye.
