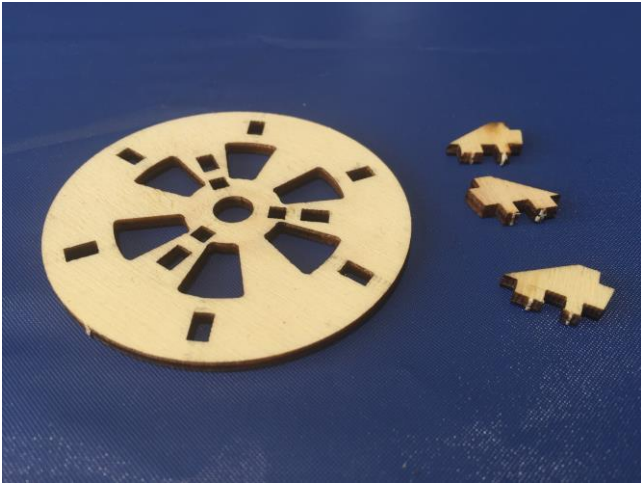


Hummer 1



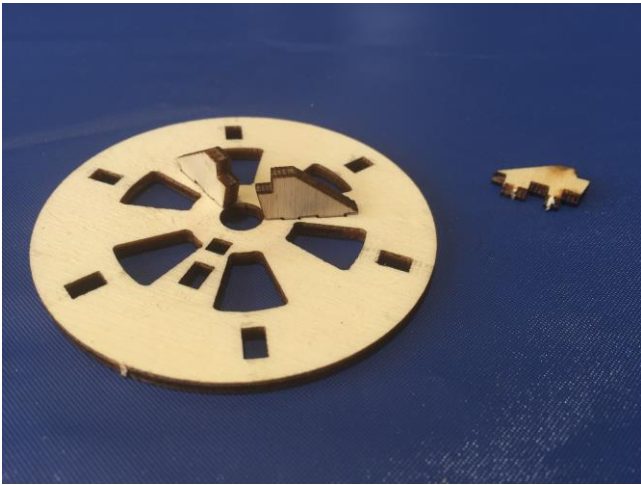
Before starting, make sure each student has a plastic bag with his name on it.

All completed parts will be kept in the bag.

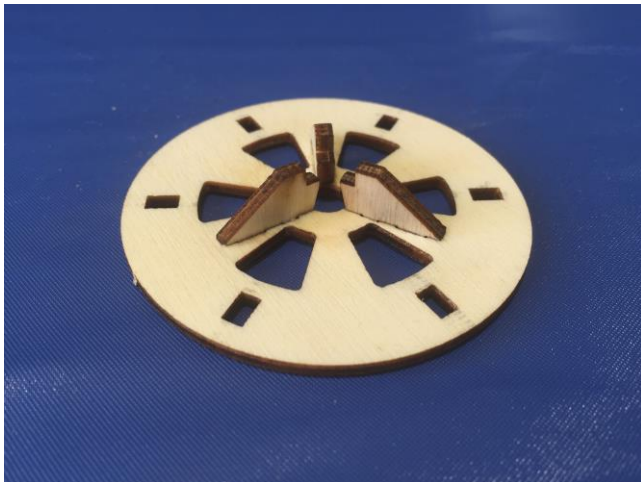
Cover all tables with table cloths.

Pop out the parts shown in the picture. Make sure you are taking the right wheel. This one has a small round crack in the center.

One wheel at a time, DO NOT pop out all the wheels at once.

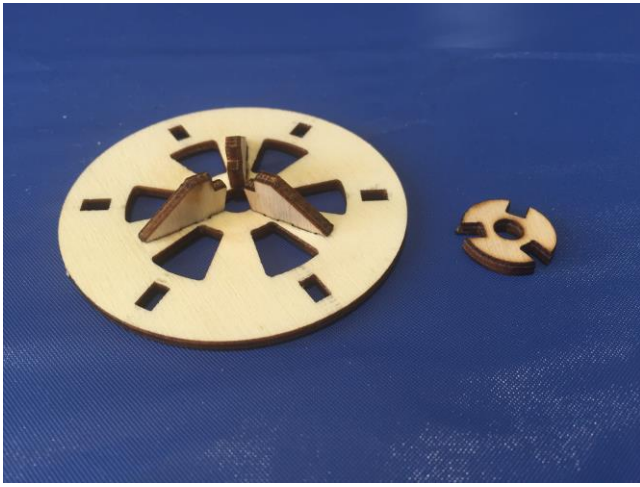


Start gluing the parts around the small circle.

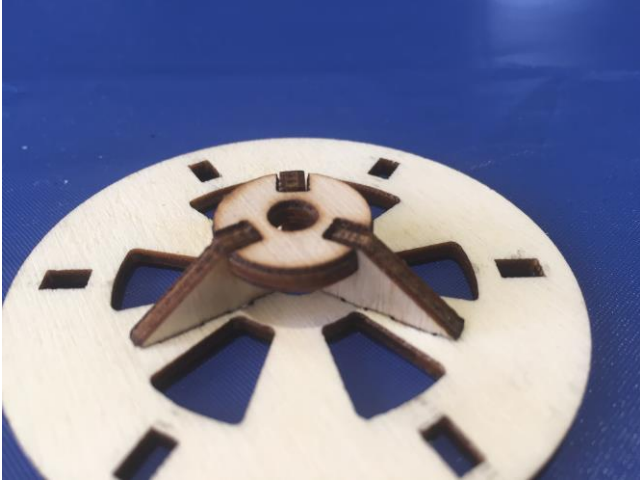
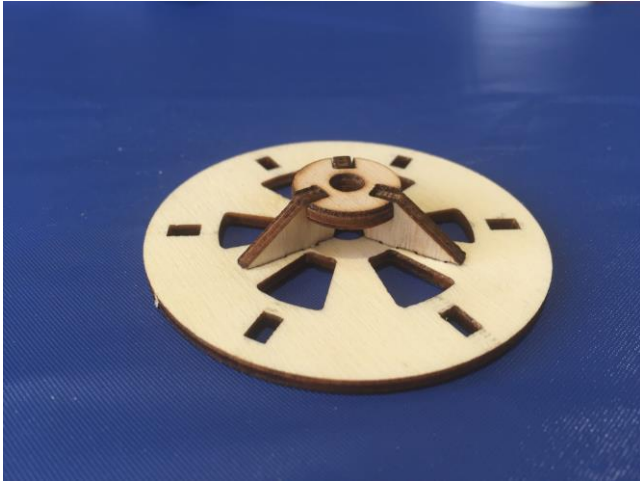


CHECKPOINT!

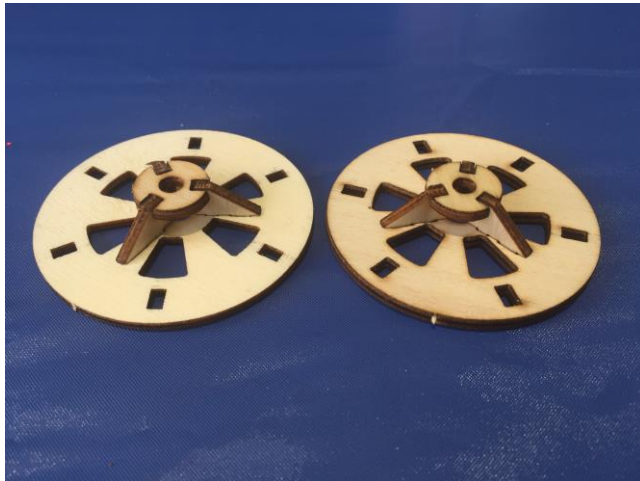
Check all models make sure the students glued the small parts correctly.



Once checked and confirmed, pop out the small round part shown in the picture.



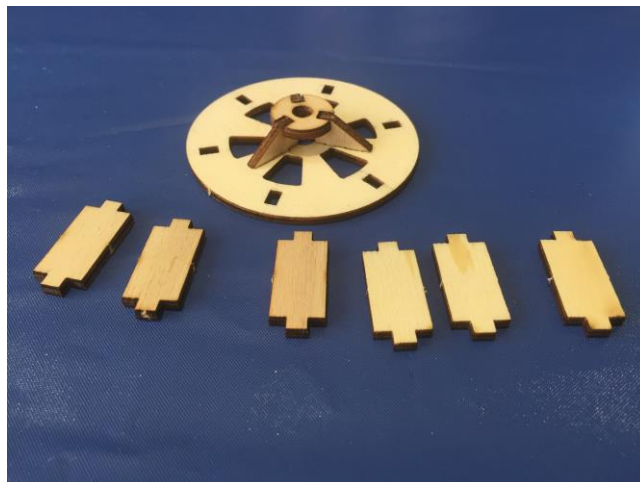
Carefully glue it to the center of the small triangles.



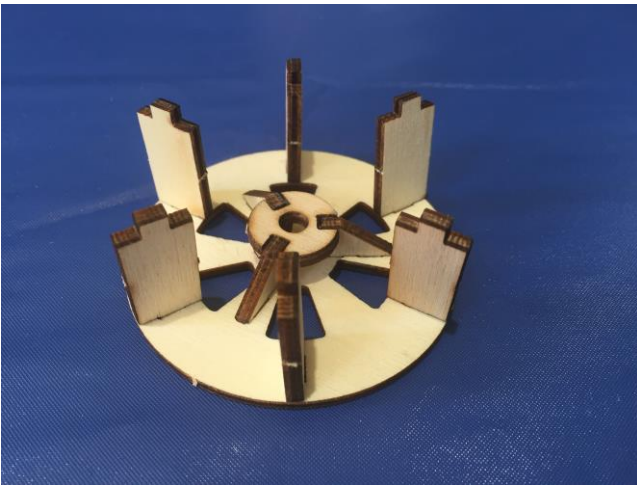
Check the first one, if assembled correctly continue to the second wheel, go through all the steps again.

CHECKPOINT!!!

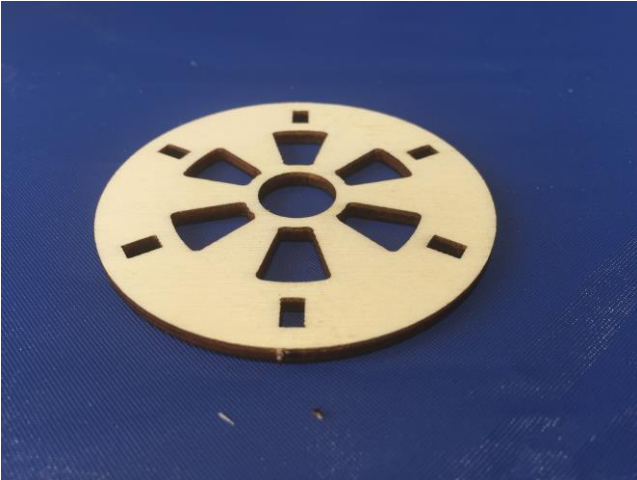
Check both wheels once done.



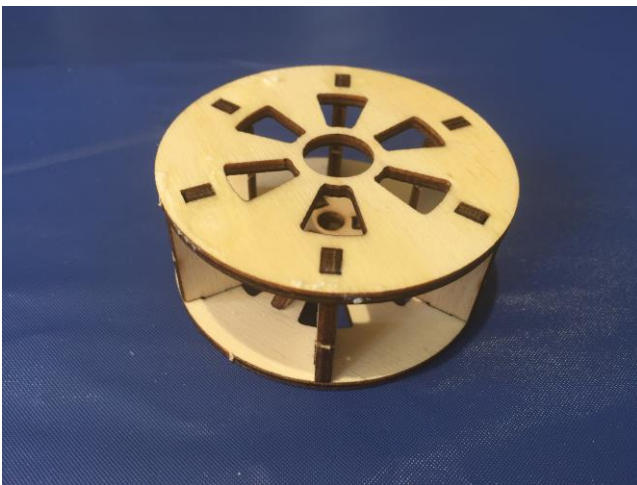
Once done, pop out 6 rectangular walls



Glue them into the crack on the wheel



Pop out the wheel with the **large round hole in the center**



Apply glue on the top of each wall and place the large wheel on top of the walls.

Align the holes so all the wall are inserted correctly into the large wheel.



Check all the wheels, if assembled correctly, continue and assemble the 2nd wheel. Repeat the steps until you have 2 completed wheels.

CHECKPOINT!!!

Check both wheels and make sure they are properly assembled.

Let the part dry, meanwhile you can color the other wooden sheets.

Once done, put all the completed parts in the plastic bags, collect the bags and clean the classroom.
