


### T-Rex lesson plan #4



Disassemble and file head parts. Then, let students try and assemble head on their own. Check students' work once finished.



Disassemble and file body parts.



Glue small pieces to the fitting holes. Notice pieces are inserted all the way.



Then, connect the body's front part.



Disassemble and carefully file ribs.



Glue the 3 small ribs in the back (closest to the tail). Then, glue the rest from the tail up. **The 2 front holes remain empty!**



Glue the large ribs.



Glue these ribs so that the walls' sticking out sides face backward, as shown in the photo!



Glue head in its place.



Disassemble and carefully file arms. Then, hand each student 2 paper fasteners.



Connect arm through the second (bottom) hole to the front ribs' wall using the paper fastener.



Connect second arm through the second (bottom) hole to the front ribs' wall using the paper fastener.



Glue body to card at the card's front and back holes.



This is the body after gluing the card.



File parts remaining. Connect wooden piece using a paper fastener. Connect arm's top hole to leg's top hole.



Do the same on the other side, and your model is complete! Go around the classroom with a pair of batteries, and make sure students' models function. If a problem occurs, make sure screws aren't too tight.
