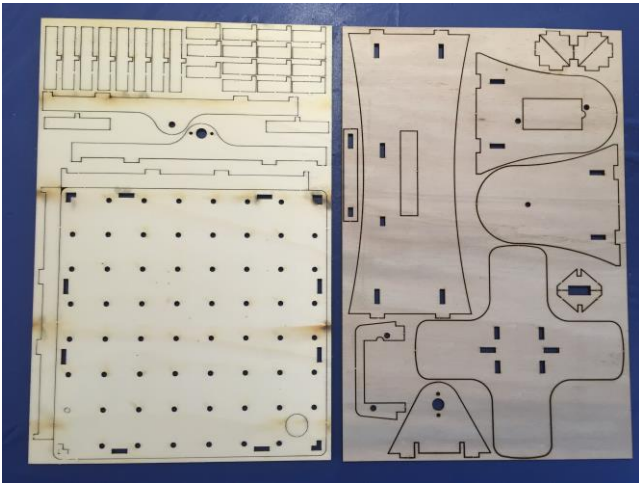


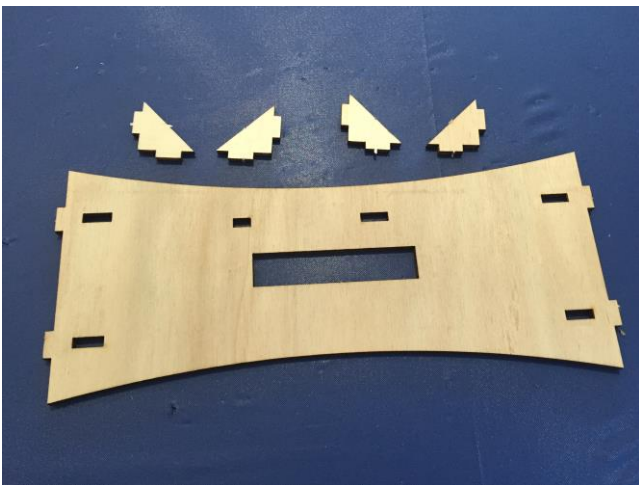
Maze 1



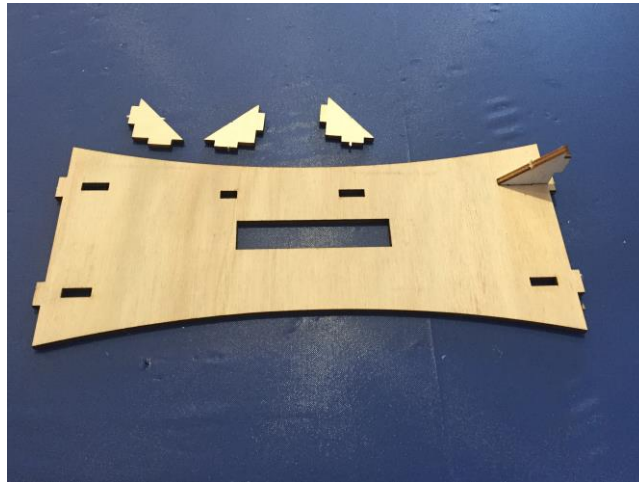
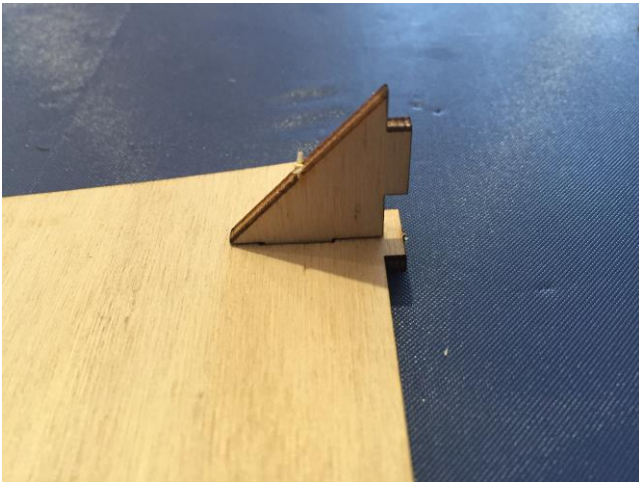
Before starting, make sure each student has a bag with his name on it.

All completed parts will be kept in the bag.

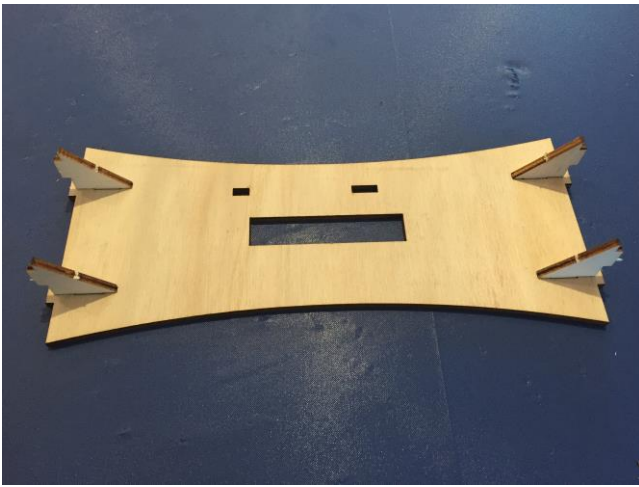
Cover all tables with table cloths.



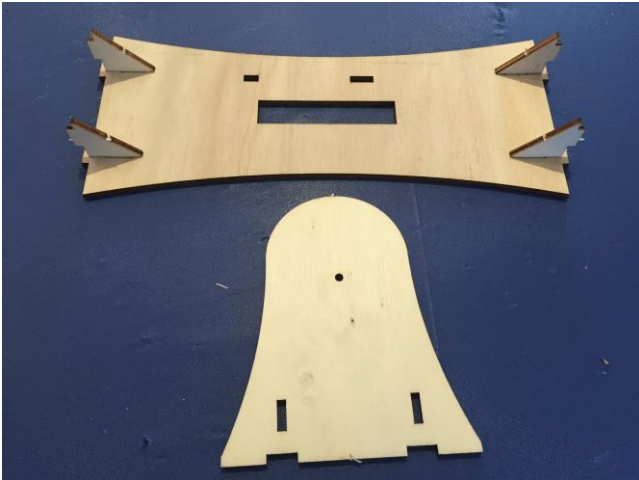
Pop out the parts shown in the picture.



First Glue 1 triangle, so the straight part is facing out.



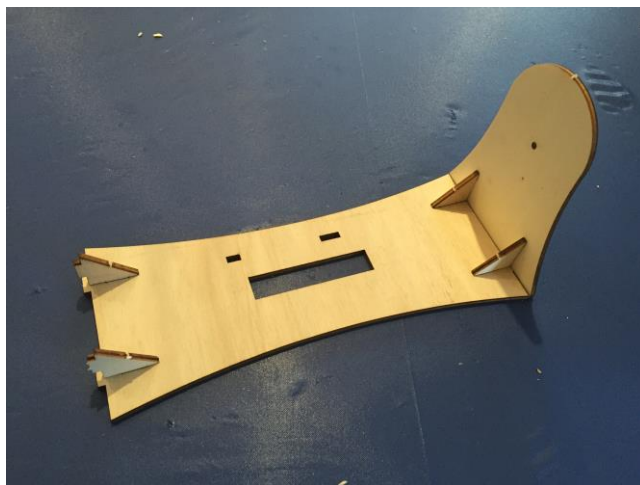
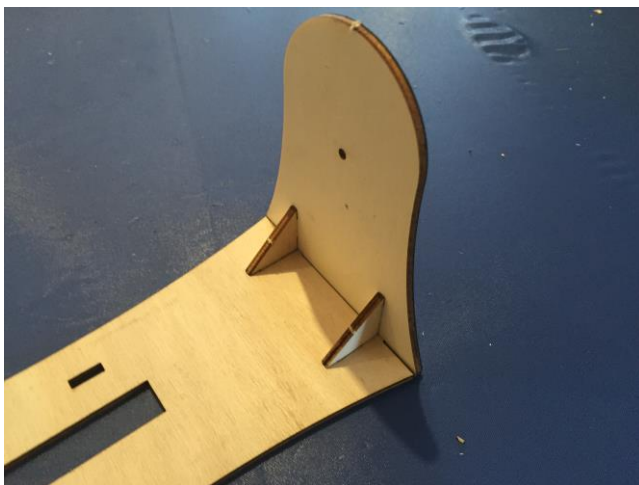
If the students got glued the first one right, let them glue all the triangles.



Checkpoint!!!

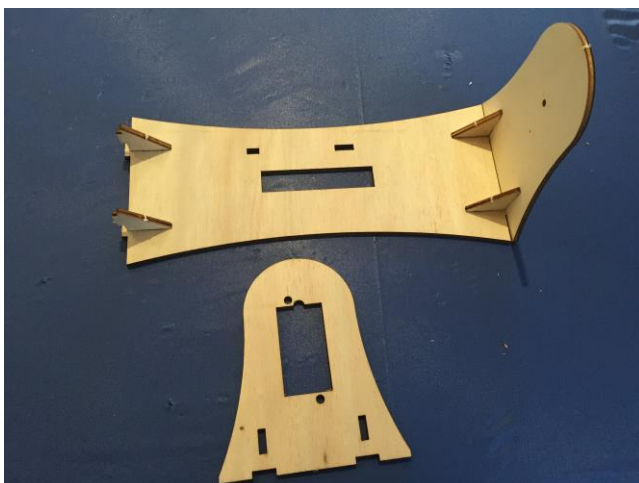
Check all the models before moving on.

Once checked, pop out the part shown in the picture.

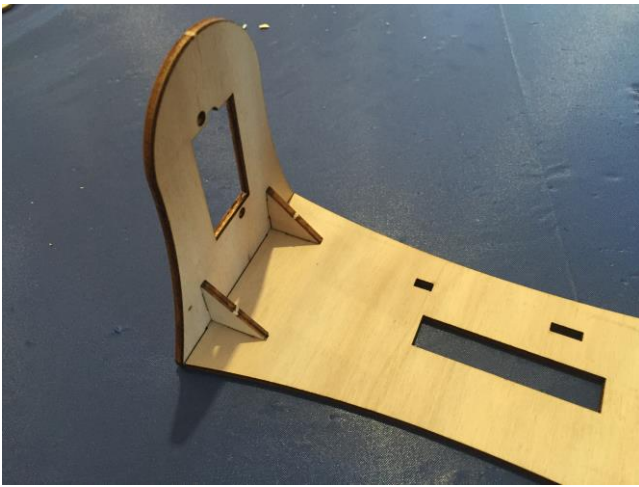


Glue it to one of the side
(doesn't matter which side)

Make sure the students work on the table, it will help them to balance the parts out until the glue dries.

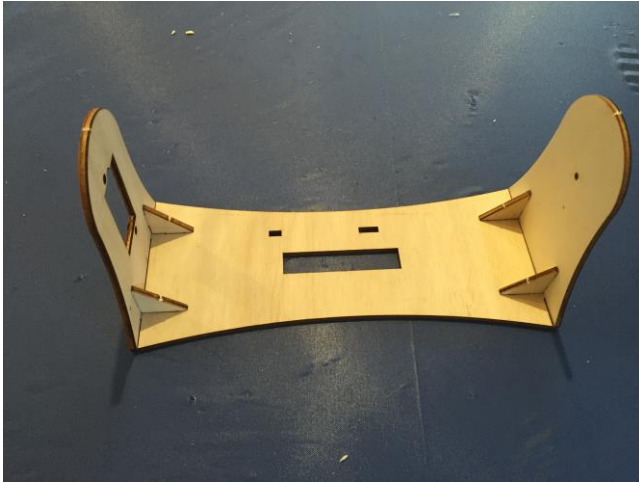


Once done, pop out the new part shown in the picture.



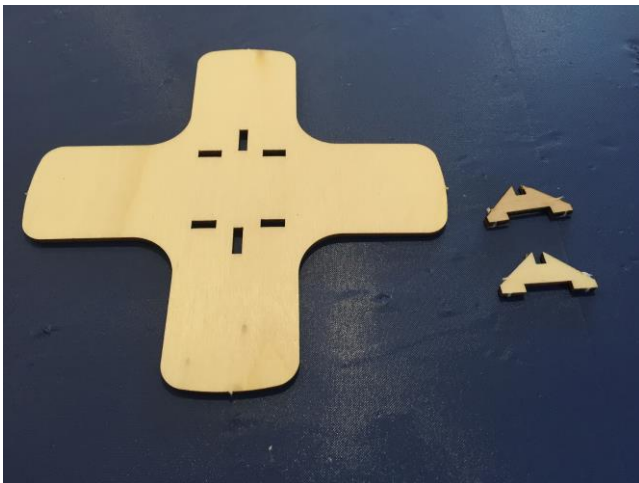
Glue the new part to the other side.

Again make sure to place it on the table.



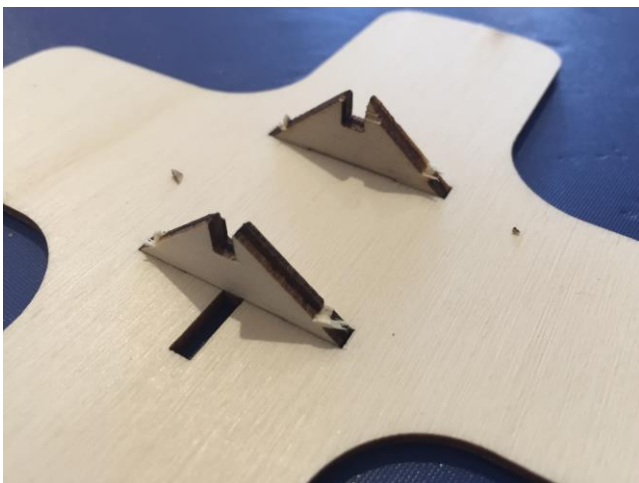
CHECKPOINT!!!

Check all the models, if the students assembled the models right let them dry until the end of the class.



Once checked, continue to the next part.

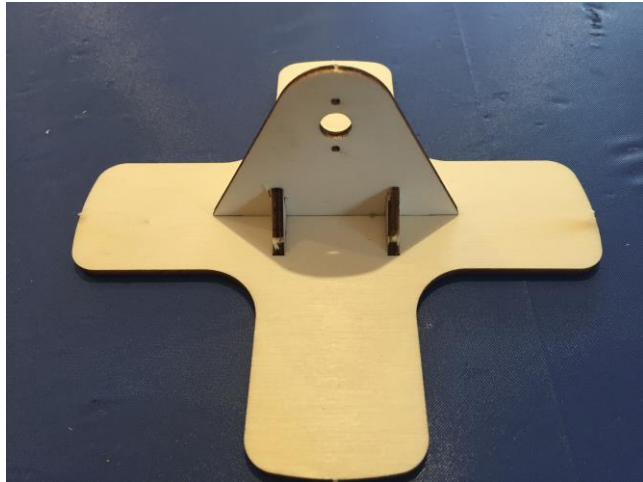
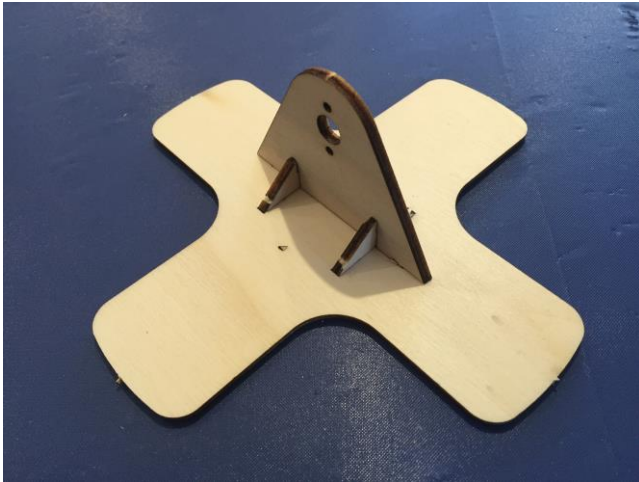
Pop out the parts shown in the picture.



Glue both parts in their proper place.



Pop out the new piece shown in the picture.



Glue it to its place, make sure the part is inserted all the way in or else our maze will not be balanced.

CHECKPOINT!!!!

Check all the parts we assembled this lesson.

If you have time, let the parts dry and start coloring the other wooden sheet.

If not, have the students carefully place the glued parts in their bags. Collect all the plastic bags from the students and clean the classroom.
